### **A Tea/Coffee Pot Cover with Needle Felted Embellishment**

Each Competitor will be responsible for their entry, suitably packed for onward transporting, being delivered to SWRI Headquarters, 42 Heriot Row, Edinburgh, EH3 6ES either by hand or post and to arrive not later than **Friday 03 August 2012**.

SWRI cannot be held responsible for an entry arriving damaged or late.

Judging will take place at Headquarters during the week commencing 06 August 2012.

Headquarters will arrange for the unpacking and repacking of entries at the time of judging. Arrangements will also be made to transfer the entries to the venue of the exhibition and to set up.
